Dear Bristol Township School District Families,

We are completing a successful and safe second marking period with the Hybrid Model. Our Health and Safety Plan has been implemented effectively. Students and staff are adjusting to the hybrid and virtual environments and we are looking forward to continued success. The third marking period begins on Friday, January 29, 2021.

For the third marking period, you will have the opportunity to change your child's status for attendance. If for any reason you want to change your child to hybrid from virtual or to virtual from hybrid, this is the time to do so. Each building principal will send out a form to change your child's status. **The form is for a change in status only.** If you have any questions, please contact your child's school.

We will return to the hybrid model on Monday, January 11, 2021. As a health reminder, students who have had close contact with a positive case, should stay at home and call the school to notify the health office. Students who are experiencing any of the COVID-19 symptoms such as fever, cough, sore throat, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, shortness of breath, headache, fatigue, or any of the symptoms listed on the [health screener](#) should not come to school.
